

KEDC received and accepted one bid for Cellular Telephone Service. We did not receive any bids from Long Distance Carriers.

KEDC's Executive Director has accepted the Cellular Telephone Service Bid from BellSouth Mobility. The KEDC Board of Directors will formally accept the bid at their next board meeting on January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2000. You should consider this bid complete for purposes of filing your Year 4 USF 471 application. The bid includes two types of cellular service, Nationwide and Regional. The Cellular Plans are described below:

Calls placed from within your region to a telephone within your region are free of roaming and long distance charges. Calls made outside of your region incur a \$0.69 per minute roaming charge. Calls from within your region to outside your region will incur a \$0.15 long distance charge. You may choose between the Midwest Region and Southeast Region. The Midwest Region includes Kentucky, Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Ohio, Wisconsin, Iowa, Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Tennessee. The Southeast Region includes Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, and Arkansas.

**The following items apply to both Nationwide and Regional service.**

1. Fee to activate a cellular telephone - \$0.00
2. Unused minutes do not roll over to the next month.
3. Requires a 12-month agreement.
4. Charges additional to the monthly charge:
  - Emergency 911 - \$0.70 per month
  - USF - \$0.32 per month
  - Landline connect fee (if you call mobile to landline) - \$1.24 per month
  - KY Life Line - \$0.05 per month
  - School tax based upon county
5. See the Local Access Number Availability List below to determine if your district will be assigned a local telephone number for your cellular service.
6. Reports will be generated showing airtime minutes of use, average monthly charge, and suggested charges.
7. Training on the equipment and services will be provided.
8. Caller ID, call waiting, voice mail, call forwarding, and three way calling are included.
9. BellSouth Mobility is unable to bill the USF for their portion of the cellular service. The district will use the BEAR form to obtain reimbursement for cellular service expenses.
10. Local numbers will be provided for technical support and repair service.

11. Fifty percent of airtime must be used within BellSouth Mobility market.
